

Part D: ABOUT OUR ASSETS
PHYSICAL RESOURCES

Roxboro United Church owns no real estate or major capital resources that are not part of the church building, which of course is the property of the United Church. However, we have a number of moveable assets such as duplicating equipment, computers, audio-video equipment and a sophisticated sanctuary sound system with wireless microphones. As well, the members purchased and installed a two manual, 18 stop Warren/Casavant pipe organ in 1994, which had been released from a Quebec university. This was arranged through a local organ builder, and the organ is maintained by church members.

We have our own web site, **www.roxborounitedchurch.org** which is updated regularly by the Minister and our Office Administrator.

Because it has one of largest room capacities in the area, Roxboro United Church has served as a polling station, an emergency shelter during the ice storm, and as a site for other non-church related events. Given its large size and variety of facilities, the church's space is frequently used by outside groups, on a pay-for-use or free basis, depending upon the type of group requiring space. A nursery school rents a large room on a full time basis. There is a large kitchen with two stoves, an industrial dishwasher, and several refrigerators and freezers. We have a large auditorium with stage, a parlor, and several Sunday School rooms. The large church parking lot is used extensively on week days by those visiting the Roxboro library and by the staff of the private school across the street. In recognition of this use, the Borough of Pierrefonds/Roxboro provides snow clearing and other maintenance of the lot.
